The sixth regular meeting of the Zumbro Falls 115<sup>th</sup> Council met June 10, 2009. The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all members present. A motion made by Christenson to accept the Clerk's report with the amendment of the Lion's purchase of the new picnic table, was seconded by Solomonson. Carried 5-0. Christenson made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report, Sec. by Wilhelm . Car. 5-0.

Bruce Heitmann gave the Fire Department report that nothing major was happening. A rock by Moreland's fire hydrant has to clear by a 3' radius and is being looked at.

Furnace finished, sink needs venting, otherwise remodeling complete. The 63 bridge construction will not be happening until next year. The Mayor will call a meeting with Fire Department, Sheriff, and affected business owners to discuss the project with traffic control being one of the topics .The State needs to be sent a registered letter concerning the bulging retaining wall. Dallas reported 2 white picnic tables were damaged by kids. The Community Service workers aren't willing to work. Mayor VanDeWalker asked for the Councils OK to buy a gas powered tree trimmer for \$300-\$500 for trimming branches by roadsides. Motion by Christenson, sec.by Wilhelm, Car. 5-0 to purchase tree trimmer. Pussycat Cabaret has not been open for business since the last court date. Overnight camping is not permitted at the park. City agreed to reimburse Dallas for the camera video bill presented for the sewer blockage in the street by his house. Christenson motion, sec. Solomonson, car 5-0 to reimburse Dallas. Adam's house did not sell. The planning department at Xcel has not contacted the Mayor regarding the new street lights. Not sure if Faas' place has sold, but Anding's have used the dumpster there to clean up their yard. Motion by Wilhelm, sec. by Christenson to send clean up letter to those residences needing it. Car 5-0. Gravel is needed up by Maass', VanDeWalkers, and at park. Motion by Solomonson, sec by Wilhelm car 5-0 for gravel replacement. A check for the repair of the fire hydrant was received. No response on the tower rust spot. A monitor for well PC is being checked on. Internet testing is being done at the tower with possible rent of \$100-150 generated from it. Checking on pressure sensor for going forward. Christenson supplied list of outstanding Sewer & Water bills. Wilhelm presented the Spring Clean Up Days numbers with a possible earnings of \$45. Christenson made a motion to approve bills and adjourn. Solomonson sec, car 5-0.
